

# Mays Chapel Elementary School's Reopening Information

Arrival: 9:05 – 9:20 a.m.

Dismissal: 3:50 – 4:05 p.m.

We are looking forward to transitioning to hybrid instruction! This is new for all of us. We will continue to communicate important information and updates. Here are some important reminders to help you and your child prepare for returning to the building:

<p><b>Arrival &amp; Dismissal Procedures:</b></p> <p>Please watch the 2 min video to learn about our arrival and dismissal procedures during hybrid instruction.</p> <p><a href="#"><u>Arrival and Dismissal Procedures during Hybrid Instruction</u></a></p>	<p><b>Face Covering:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Face coverings are required for all persons in a BCPS facility or vehicle as well as on BCPS property. Face coverings are required during transportation to/from school on a bus as well as outdoors on campuses.</li><li>• Each school, office, and school bus will have a supply of disposable face coverings for students and employees who forget their face covering or whose face covering becomes soiled or damaged.</li></ul>
<p><b>Screening &amp; Stay Home When Appropriate:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• All employees and students are expected to screen themselves daily for symptoms of COVID-19.</li><li>• <b>Remain home</b> if you have symptoms, confirmed COVID-19 illness, had recent contact with a person with COVID-19 and/or awaiting test results.</li><li>• Parents will receive a screening checklist and magnet with the screening practices.</li></ul>	<p><b>Social Distancing:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Classroom furniture is arranged to provide 6-foot separation between students, when possible.</li><li>• Reduce gathering of students in any area – refer to changes in arrival and dismissal procedures and movement in the hallways.</li></ul>
<p><b>Hand Hygiene:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Times for handwashing to include before and after meals, upon arrival to schools' offices and home, before and after use of any shared items, after use of the restroom, after sneezing/coughing and other time hands are contaminated</li></ul>	<p><b>Breakfast &amp; Lunch:</b></p> <p><b>Breakfast – eaten in classroom</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Grab and go pre-packaged breakfast meal available to all.</li><li>• Two stations will be set up daily at our two entry points identified in our arrival and dismissal plan.</li></ul> <p><b>Lunch - eaten in the cafeteria</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Students can receive a no cost lunch or bring a packed lunch.</li><li>• Students will be designated to areas by classes, 6 feet apart alternating seats 3 to a table.</li><li>• Desks may be added for spacing.</li><li>• Sneeze guards and sit/don't sit markers</li></ul>

## Supplies & Devices:

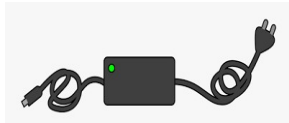
### MATERIALS AND SUPPLIES MAY NOT BE SHARED

#### FULLY CHARGED Device

- 2 Face Coverings (1 worn, 1 back-up)
- Water bottle
- Backpack
- Clothing appropriate for the weather for breaks, recess, and, outdoor learning when appropriate.

#### PTO will provide welcome kits:

- Class basket: For the teacher including extra student supplies and additional PPE items
- Desk Kits: With basic student school supplies for each student.



## Visitors:

- To visit a BCPS school, visitors must have an appointment.
- Visits will be conducted remotely or outside, whenever possible.
- If an indoor visit is required, visitors will be required to wear a face coverings and practice social distancing.
- The number of people admitted to the building will be limited.

## Mark your Calendars for ...

### Students in grades K-2, who opt for hybrid instruction, return...

- Cohort A returns on Monday, 3/1
- Cohort B returns on Thursday, 3/4
- School schedules change for ALL students
- 9:05 am arrival, instruction begins at 9:20 am (for hybrid and virtual)
- Special areas, lunch, recess, and academic times shared on 2/22

#### March 1 – March 12

- Gr. K-2 hybrid students will have early dismissal at 1:50 pm (asych PM)
- Gr. K-2 virtual students have synchronous instruction from 2:20 pm – 3:30 pm (blended experience prior to 2:20)
- Gr. 3 – 5 will continue to receive virtual instruction following the new schedule, 9:20 am – 3:50 pm

#### March 15 – April 6

- All students return to the full day schedule, 9:05 am – 3:50 pm
- Early dismissal discontinued for PreK-2
- Schedule changes will occur for Pre K-2, both hybrid and virtual.
- Special area schedules will remain the same.
- Schedules will remain the same for Gr. 3-5 beginning March 1st.

#### April 6 (FOLLOWING SPRING BREAK)

- Students in Gr. 3-5 who opt into hybrid learning will return
- Cohort A returns Tuesday, 4/6
- Cohort B returns Thursday, 4/8
- Schedules will remain the same for Gr. K-2
